Learner Worksheet 1

Pre-listening

Predict: Look at the pictures. Who/where are the people? What are they doing? What can you see in the picture?

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Follow up activities:

- Elicit further related vocabulary
- Facilitate syllable matching activity.
- Ask students to practice spellings as homework for a spelling test.
- Make a crossword using the pictures as clues and students will be expected to spell words correctly on the crossword.
