Qualification Overview

The Ascentis Entry 3 Award in Introduction to Safeguarding qualification is designed to give learners knowledge and understanding of safeguarding, including the meaning and basic principles of safeguarding, types of abuse and their recognition features and possible safeguarding issues caused by modern technology.
